

Irene Rathbone Matchplay Trophy

Format: A match play competition played off full of the handicap over 18 holes. (NB the lowest handicap player plays off scratch; the opponent receives the full handicap difference)

Tees: Red

Entry requirements: Open to Female members with an active handicap of 36 or less.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted on the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date.

Closing Date: The entry list will be closed 9 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: £2.00 per player **to be paid prior to playing the first round.** Payment to be put in an envelope and marked with name and competition, and placed in the locked box in the locker room.

Prizes: Winner and runner up which will be presented at the Ladies' Presentation Evening.

Special Notes:

1. In the event of a halved match, the players will continue with sudden death continuing from the 10th tee. Handicap entitlement remains intact during sudden death play.
2. It is the responsibility of both players to arrange their match. If both players cannot agree a match date, the Competition secretary will book a tee and advise both players of the time and date. Whichever player is on the tee at the appointed time will be declared the winner. If neither player is present a bye will be awarded to the next rounds opponent. If both players are late the 1st hole is deemed to be halved and the match would start on the 2nd hole. (Rule 6-3a/3).
3. A card must be kept for the match and signed by both players. It must be posted in the scorecard box.
4. Players will play off full handicap as stated on the day of the match.

Lady Captain's Trophy/Ladies Championship

Format: An 18 hole stroke play competition. Competitors are entitled to their full handicap.

Tees: Red

Entry requirements: Open to female members only with an active handicap of 36 or less.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted on the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date.

Closing Date: The entry list will be closed 9 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: £2.00 per player

Prizes: Winner (Club Champion) and runner-up to be presented at the Ladies' Presentation Evening.

Captain's Day

Format: To be announced on the entry sheet.

Tees: Red

Entry requirements: As decided by the Captain and included on the entry sheet.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted on the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date.

Closing Date: The entry list will be closed 9 days before the start of the competition when the draw will be made and displayed on the notice board.

Entry Fee: £3.00 per player. The entry fee will be donated to the Captain's nominated charity.

Food: If required there may be a small extra charge.

Prizes: As decided by the Captain on the day.

Medal

Format: A stroke play competition played off the full handicap of competing players over 18 holes.

Tees: Red

Entry requirements: Open to all female members who have a handicap of 36 or less.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted on the notice board at least 4 weeks before the date of the competition.

Closing Date: The entry list will be closed on the day of the competition.

Entry Fee: £2.00 per player

Prizes: A small trophy and voucher will be awarded to the winner of however many divisions are competed during the current season. A voucher will be awarded to the runner-up in each such division. (The number of divisions may vary from season to season dependant upon the numbers of entries to the competitions.) These will be presented at the Ladies' Presentation Evening.

Special Notes:

1. The Competition secretary will block book tee times for the morning of the competition day. Special requests for later tee times must be made separately, directly to the Competition secretary.
2. Entrants are responsible for **LEGIBLY** writing their **OWN** name on the entry sheet.

January 2010

Stableford

Format: A stableford competition played off the full handicap of competing players over 18 holes.

Tees: Red

Entry requirements: Open to all female members who have a handicap of 36 or less.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted on the notice board at least 4 weeks before the date of the competition.

Closing Date: 7 days before the competition date, when the draw will be made and displayed on the notice board.

Entry Fee: £2.00 per player.

Prizes available to: 1st and 2nd consisting of vouchers which will be presented at the Ladies Presentation Evening.

January 2010

9-hole Qualifying Winners Challenge Trophy

Format: A 9-hole Stableford competition in one division played off the 9-hole qualifier handicap.

Tees: Red

Entry requirements: Open to all winners of the 9-hole qualifying competitions from March to September of the current season.

Entry List: A list of qualifiers will be posted on the notice board at least 2 weeks in advance. Each player must confirm her availability to play by ticking the list.

Entry Fee: £2.00

Prizes: Winner to be presented at the Ladies' Presentation Evening.

January 2010

3 Clubs and a Putter

Format: A 9-hole stroke-play competition off full handicap using a maximum of 3 clubs and a putter. The competition will be played on the front 9 (Telford side).

Tees: Red

Entry requirements: Open to all female members with an active handicap of 36 or less.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted on the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date.

Closing Date: The entry list will be closed 9 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: £2.00 per player.

Prizes: Winner and runner up to be presented at the Ladies' presentation evening.

January 2010

Mixed Doubles

Format: A pairs Stableford competition played off Full handicap of the competing players over 18 holes with both scores to count. Maximum handicap of 24 for men and 36 for ladies.

Tees: White and Red

Entry requirements: Open to ladies and gents as a pair. Juniors are permitted if they have a handicap of 28 or less in the case of males and a handicap of 36 or less in the case of females. Players handicaps must be active. A maximum of only one junior is permitted per pair.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted on the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date.

Closing Date: The entry list will be closed 9 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: £5.00 per player.

Prizes: Winners, runners up and 3rd place, to be presented at the Club presentation evening.

Medal Winners Challenge Trophy

Format: A stroke-play competition in the number of divisions played in the season off full handicap over 18 holes. Players who have won a medal in more than one division will play in the lowest division in which they won.

Tees: Red

Entry requirements: Open to all winners of the Monthly Medal in each division from April to October of the current season.

Entry List: A list of qualifiers will be posted on the notice board at least 2 weeks in advance. Each player must confirm her availability to play by ticking the list.

Entry Fee: £3.00

Prizes: Winner of each division, to be presented at the Ladies' Presentation Evening.

January 2010

The Benbrooke Consolation Cup

Format: A 9-hole Stableford competition in one division played off the 9-hole qualifying handicap, played on the back nine (Wrekin Side).

Tees: Red

Entry requirements: Open to all female members who have **NOT** won a 9-hole qualifier, a Medal or a Trophy during the current season. Entrants **MUST** have played in at least **one** 9 hole qualifying competition, a medal or a trophy competition during the **current season**.

Entry List: a list of qualifying ladies will be posted on the notice board at least 4 weeks in advance, which you will be required to tick if you wish to enter the competition. The list will be taken down 9 days before the competition. A draw will be made and the list of tee times will be posted at least seven days before the date of the competition.

Entry Fee: £2.00

Prizes: There will be a Trophy for the winner to be presented at the Ladies' presentation evening.

January 2010

The Inaugural Cup

Format: An 18-hole Greensomes competition in one division played using the CONGU recommended greensomes handicapping format.

Tees: Red

Entry requirements: Open to all female members who have an active handicap of 36 or less. Entries to be made a pairs. Ladies may choose their own partners, but in the event of a lady wishing to play who has no partner they may enter the competition and attempts will be made to match them to a partner.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted on the notice board at least 4 weeks prior to the competition. Entries will close 7 days before the competition when tee times will be posted.

Entry Fee: £2.00 per player.

Prizes: There will be Trophies for the winners to be presented on Ladies Presentation Evening. There will be vouchers for the runners up.

January 2010

Seniors Mixed Pairs Challenge Trophy

Format: A mixed Greensomes competition played off full handicap of the competing players over 18 holes adjusted using the CONGU recommended greensomes handicapping format. Maximum handicap of 28 for men and 36 for ladies.

Tees: Yellow and Red.

Entry Requirements: Open to ladies and gents who are aged 55 or over on the day of the competition who have active handicaps. Pairs will be drawn from the entry lists of both gentlemen and ladies. If there are surplus gentlemen or ladies those with the highest handicaps will be ineligible working up the list in order of entry.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted on the notice boards of the ladies and the senior gents at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date.

Closing Date: The entry list will be closed 9 days before the start of the competition when the draw will be made and the tee times displayed on both notice boards.

Entry Fee: £2.00 per player.

Prizes: Winners, runners up and 3rd place to be presented at the Senior Gents Presentation event.

The Material Magic Trophy

This Trophy, donated by Susan Hancock, is awarded to the lady with the highest total number of points in her best three 18 hole Stableford competitions of the season.

It is awarded at the presentation evening.

Summer and Winter Eclectic

Summer Eclectic to be played from 1st May to 30th September, and the Winter Eclectic from 1st October to 30th April.

Up to five rounds can be played on both nines, they do not necessarily need to be played at the same time.

Eclectic rounds can be played in conjunction with any medal or Stableford singles competition, but not with a 4BBB or matchplay competition.

Players MUST indicate their intention to play BEFORE they go out, and date and sign the book to show this.

Cards must be marked and signed in the usual way, by a member of Horsehay Ladies Section who has a full CONGU handicap, and the cards put in the competition box in the ladies locker room.

Entry Fee is £2.00 for each competition, to be paid before the first round is played.

Handicaps will be taken into account at the end of the competition, based upon the players handicap at the commencement of the competition date.
