Rule 27-2b

The player may play a Provisional Ball until he reaches the place where his original ball is likely to be. If he makes a stroke with the Provisional Ball from that point or a point closer to the hole, the original ball is 'Lost' and the Provisional Ball becomes the ball in play under penalty of stroke and distance.
