

HVGC junior members achieve County recognition

Following on from the merited accolade of being selected for further winter and spring coaching from Michael Welch, professional coach to Shropshire and Herefordshire Union of Golf Clubs, two of the junior golfers at HVGC have been selected to represent the county in a competitive league fixture against Nottinghamshire.

Harry Burt and **Lewis Horobin** were selected for the u14 and u16 teams respectively, with both of these juniors being selected ahead of their actual ages (11 and 14), again reflecting how highly these (and other HVGC) young golfers are respected by the SHUGC Junior Committee.
